## Plain Weave in Multiples G25070108

Welcome Weavers,

This week together includes hands-on creation around a woven textile. It is a class to challenge a beginner weaver; no experience is necessary. It is also an adventure for someone wanting to refresh their weaving skills. Everyone in the workshop will have a finished weaving project at the end of the week. You should expect to put in at least 4-5 hours a day weaving (possibly more)!

I have taught handwork for many years-from spinning the actual thread to knitting and/or weaving fabric. For me, using a natural fiber to create fabric is very basic; it's been done and will continue to be done for centuries. The practice of weaving varies across the world and I will give you some basic skills to grow your weaving knowledge. We will cover various vocabulary as well as simple math that will lead to a better understanding of the common sense of it all!

There will be a 4-harness floor loom for each student and all the equipment needed to finish this project. Expect to put aside at least 4-5 hours of weaving a day and you will have a finished project at the end of the week!

Please bring notebook, pencil, large eye needle and a tape measure.

- -Evenings for a couple hours after dinner.
